

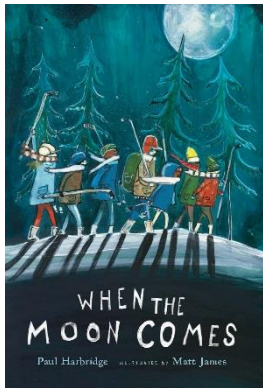

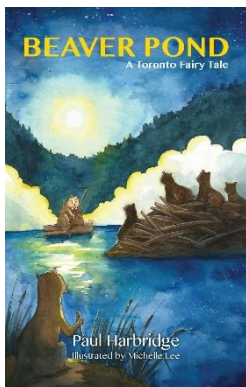
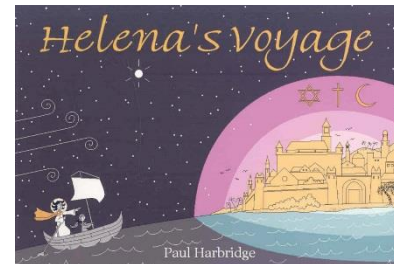
## ***Helena's Voyage*** (2008 O Books UK)

Helena's Voyage is the story of a sick little girl taken on a night journey. An angel takes her in his sailboat to visit a Jewish city, a Christian city and a Muslim city. The pair then travel to a war-torn area where Helena befriends a war-orphaned boy named Abraham, the historical father of the three religions.

This story is a tribute to the author's daughter, Helena Harbridge, who died in her sleep in April 2006 at age 18 of a suspected heart arrhythmia. She was attending the University of West Georgia on a golf scholarship, where she led her team to three wins that first year, and won one tournament, all while on track to a 4.0 grade point average.
